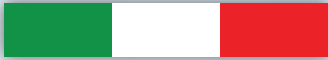

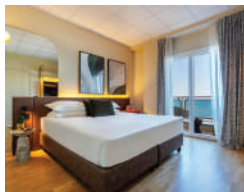

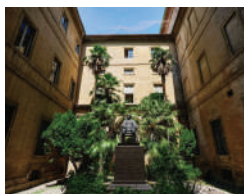

## 01 How to Apply?

1. Visit [www.fingerwaltzmusicproductions.com/winterpiano](https://www.fingerwaltzmusicproductions.com/winterpiano) to complete your application ASAP.
  2. A minimum piano playing level of **Grade 6 or above** is required to join the event.
  3. Submit a video of your piano performance along with your application.
  4. Applications are subject to acceptance and will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

## 02 Fees and Packages

1. Early Bird Discount:  
Submit your application **before 27 OCT 2024** to receive EUR 100 off.
2. Fees:
  - **EUR 3,600 per participant**
  - **EUR 2,100 for accompanying adults**
  - **EUR 1,500 for children under 12**

All fees include accommodation with full board (three meals per day), rights to observe all the masterclasses, transportation and tickets for excursions to San Marino and the ski resort.

Participants will also have 4 individual masterclasses, unlimited piano practice at the Rossini Conservatory, as well as rehearsal and performance opportunities with the orchestra and a final concert.


